

## Oak's Hardware

Located at 1519 Como Ave. SE, this storefront has always been a hardware store (built circa 1914) and has served as the rock of the Boyum business block between 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> Aves. SE. Oaks has been owned and operated by Pat Clough for the past 34 years. Pat was born at 12<sup>th</sup> & Como Aves SE and worked for the previous owner, Dick Oaks, before buying the business from him in 1972.

Prior owners include Dick Oaks (1956 – 1972), George Munk (circa 1940's), Alex Johnsrud (circa 1936), and Simms/Nordin (circa 1922). Robert Simms lived at 1051 SE 14<sup>th</sup> Ave. and was the son of the founder of Simms Hardware in Dinkytown. In 1922, the 1519 Como address also housed plumber John Hughes and decorators Thomason & Nordin.
