The purpose of the meeting is to present to the community the recommendations that the Blueprint Steering Committee is considering for inclusion into the Como Blueprint. It will be an opportunity for participants to ask questions and comment on the recommendations. The recommendations will be based primarily on the information gathered from Como residents and stakeholders, covering desires and concerns in areas such as transportation, housing and land use, parks and green space, livability, and other areas.

The fourth, and final public meeting, in early 2014, will be to present the final recommendations. This will be the final draft of the Como Blueprint approximately as it will be presented to the Minneapolis Planning Commission.

So mark your calendars, come to the meeting, and help your community shape the document that will guide Como neighborhood into the future: The Como Blueprint.
